All are welcome.

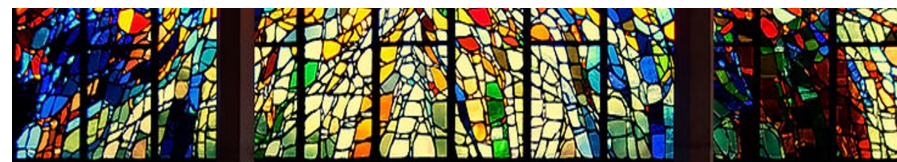
### **Nooks & Crannies**
