Music at St. Mary's (Report for the Annual Parochial Church Meeting 2026)

Choir. We maintain a nucleus each week. 'Specials' have included Choir Sunday, various Carol Services and 'Olivet to Calvary' on Good Friday, when folk from the community have joined us

Community Choir. We met at various times during the year and contributed to three concerts: VE Day, with Doncaster Wheatsheaf Singers, and when Simeon's Brass and String ensembles came in September.

Play the Organ Year. This was a national initiative during 2025 designed to raise awareness of the organ and its music. I gave demonstrations of how the organ works and spoke about some of the forms of music. Recitals were given at St. Mary's, St Winifrid's, Tickhill Methodist Church and St. Michael's, Rossington.
