Church Done Differently

Sunday 5 July at 4.00pm

Our next Church Done Differently service takes place on Sunday 5 July at 4.00pm when we will be asking the question 'Who is the greatest?' This type of service is very informal - we sit around tables, cafe-style at the back of church - and is designed for every age group from babes in arms to pensioners. We find that children come with their parents and sometimes with their grandparents as well, so all are welcome. The service lasts around 40 minutes and is packed with engaging things for children to do. We include a treasure hunt to find things hidden in church, with live music, craft activities and refreshments throughout.
